NOTICE OF REFERAL FOR COURT CASES, DISPUTE FOR LEGAL OPINION AND RE- ACTION

All Legal Practitioners, Regional Office Bearers and Regional Branch Chairman's
The Mineworkers Union of Namibia (MUN) at its 106th National Executive Committee (NEC) meeting held on Saturday, September 12th, 2009 after carefully studied the escalating legal cost, took a decision to inform all its members and contracted legal practitioner's/ consultants the following:
To avoid non payment the MUN appeal to all its Union Branches as well as the Legal fraternity that the following will have to be applied before the MUN could be made accountable for any legal fees.

1. All legal practitioners/consultants are requested not to accept any instructions from any MUN Branch. Only the MUN Head Office through its Genera! Secretary is mandated to give instructions to Lawyers to take up legal cases on behalf of any of the MUN Branches or the MUN Head Office. Disregard of this resolution will lead to non payment and MUN will not be held liable for any lack of payment for such service rendered.

Subsequently, you are all once again reminded that ail requisition to the Lawyers/Consultants for Re-action and any Application for the Establishment of Conciliation/Arbitration must be done through the Office of the MUN General Secretary.

The above will also apply when the Regional/Branch chairman wish to refer matters to the District Labour Court for Adjudication the onus here lies with the office of the General Secretary who will after consultation with the tribunal committee consider the Referral hereto.

Kindly regard the decision by the 106th NEC meeting as nothing else than a reminder to reinforce compliance and adherence to all our responsibilities.
