View Point

I want to comment on some of the activities of the S WAPO Party and to react to a number of irresponsible insinuations, innuendoes, allegations and distortions by opposition parties, particularly the new projects experimenting to enter the political realm of Namibia.

The SWAPO Party is a mass political movement worthy and proud to serve with humbleness the people of Namibia, irrespective of their colours, race, religion, gender, creed, economic status, and/or area of residence. During the 30 years of the successful liberation struggle for the independence, the SWAPO Party set out to liberate all the people of Namibia and break political, social, economic and cultural bondage, hi doing so, we aimed to achieve total emancipation of the whole being and destroy the shells of mental and physical colonialism. The SWAPO Party mobilized tens of thousands of sons and daughters of Namibia who volunteered to sacrifice their very precious lives in the pursuit of a liberated nation. They were of conviction that the only way to liberation was to cross the many rivers of blood. True to their convictions, thousands laid down their lives for the noble ideal to have a free nation.

A veiy important element of the liberation struggle waged by SWAPO was the founding of a progressive nation with its own capacity to govern itself with all essential and nonessential mechanisms in place to accelerate development. Undisputedly, the SWAPO Party was a well established government in waiting prior to taking over the reigns of power at independence. Proof in the latter was the founding of the nation and the establishment of a responsible government that has maintained peace, stability, harmony and achieved a high level of modern development. The achievements of government are attributable to the sober, persistent and collective efforts and programmes of the SWAPO Party and its adherence to the tenants of law, good governance and democracy.

Hearing the false and unsubstantiated allegations by Mr Jeremiah Nambinga is shocking in the least. Nambinga who is now placating himself as a mouth peace of RDP condemned the people of good will and humane sense for donating and supporting in material forms the SWAPO Party.

Just over a week ago, Comrade Hifikepunye Pohamba, SWAPO Party President, received a donation from a number of business enterprises based in Oshikango, Ohangwena Region. The donation was in a form of posters bearing the picture of Comrade President and other campaign materials. Mr Nambinga has stated that companies should not donate moneys or their materials to SWAPO Party only but rather to all political parties. Other opposition parties have also been heard condemning companies and individuals for giving donations to the SWAPO Party only. As is with RDP, they want the donations to be given to all political parties.

The RDP and other political parties bonding together against the SWAPO Party aim to kick up dust on a tired surface may create an impression as if the SWAPO Party has committed a crime. What is found to be strange is that the RDP and its fellow colleagues of the opposition parties seem to want to compel and force individual companies and persons to donate their moneys and materials to all political parties. The donation of any person is predicated on the democratic right of the person.

The SWAPO Party, in dealing with the Presidential and National Assembly elections, have been doing so in compliance with the Electoral Act, 1992 (Act No. 24 of 1992). The Act is clear about the conduct of the Political Parties in respect to receiving donations. Section 46 of the Electoral Act reads:

“No political party or other body or institution or any member of such party, body or institution and no other person shall from outside Namibia receive within Namibia, or bring or cause to be brought into Namibia, any money or anything which can be cashed or converted into money, which on the ground of a donation or on any other ground, is intended to be used, or in the discretion of such political party, body, institution, member or other person may be used, to further the interest of any political party or the candidature of himself or herself or any other person who has been nominated or may be nominated as a candidate for any election under this Act, or to canvass or combat any aim or principle of a political party, unless such money is disclosed to the public within such period after having received it and in such manner and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed”.

If any political party contravenes the Act and facts are established by the Electoral Commission in this respect, the Directorate of the Election in Namibia may exercise its powers to cancel the registration of such a political party as a political party.

The companies that made the donation are Namibian registered and have done so without any strings attached. No where in the Act does it states that a registered Namibian company cannot advance a donation to any political party. The SWAPO Party will continue receive donations from individual and business establishment. It has been the case in the past and will continue as such, hi case a donation is to be received from a foreign registered company or individual, surely procedures as prescribed by the law will be followed to the letter.

Since before the launching of the SWAPO Party Manifesto and the campaign for the 2009 Presidential and National Assembly Elections, the SWAPO Party has been in touch with its members, supporters and sympathizers. The number of members who have been joining the SWAPO Party has been swelling and keeps swelling.

The election campaign for the SWAPO Party has switched into high gear. In all regions and districts of the country, one finds rallies, meetings and activities of the Party taking place. This is in keeping with the spirit of the Party and the well calculated conviction of the greatest majority of Namibia that the SWAPO Party is the only Party with the genuine interest of the country and its people at heart. Their well calculated believes are based on the proven excellent track record of the SWAPO Party achievements in all areas of development.
